1	Right to receive information from the other parent concerning the health, education and welfare of the child					
2	Right to confer with the other parent, to the extent possible, before making a decision concerning the health, education and welfare of the child					
3	Right of access to medical, dental, psychological, and educational records of the child					
4	Right to consult with a physician, dentist or psychologist of the child					
5	Right to consult with school officials concerning the child's welfare and educational status, including school activities					
6	Right to attend school activities (extracurricular) activities					
7	Right to be designated on the child's record as a person to be notified in case of an emergency					
8	Right to consent for the child to medical, dental, and surgical treatment during and emergency involving immediate danger to the health and safety of the child					
9	Right to manage the child's estate to the extent the estate has been created by the parent or the parent's family					
10	Duty to inform the other parent in a timely manner of significant information concerning the health, education, and welfare of the children					
11	Duty of care, control, protection, and reasonable discipline of the child					
12	Duty to support the child, including providing the child with clothing, food, shelter, and medical and dental care not involving an invasive procedure					
13	Right to consent for the child to medical or dental care not involving an invasive procedure					
14	Right to direct the moral and religious training of the child					
15	Duty to make periodic child support payments					
16	Right to establish the primary residence of the child within _____ County or contiguous counties or with no restriction (SELECT GEOGRAPHIC AREA or NONE)					
17	Right to consent for the child to medical, dental, and surgical treatment involving invasive procedures.					
18	Right to consent for the child to in-patient psychiatric and psychological (evaluation and) treatment					
19	Right to consent for the child to out-patient psychiatric and psychological (evaluation and) treatment					
20	Right to receive and give receipt for periodic payment for the support of the child and hold or disburse these funds for the benefit of the child					
21	Right to represent the child in legal action and to make other decisions of substantial legal significance concerning the child					
22	Right to consent to marriage and enlistment in armed services of the U.S.					
23	Right to make decisions concerning the child's education (CONSIDER CHOICE OF SCHOOL DECISION)					
24	Right to the service and earning of a child					
25	Except when a guardian of the child's estate or a guardian or attorney ad litem has been appointed for the child, the right to act as an agent of the child in relation to the child's estate if the child's action is required by a state, the U.S. or a foreign government
